



## **Dolphin Decorating Instructions**

1. Base coat the entire piece with the gray paint using the smooth sponge. Rinse sponge and let piece dry.
2. Apply gray paint to the smooth sponge, then add a tiny amount of black and blend together by blotting sponge on the plate. Gently apply paint along the back and fins. Wet the textured sponge and use to blend edges. Rinse sponges.
3. Apply white paint to smooth sponge, blotting sponge on plate to remove excess paint. Gently apply white paint to belly and nose. Wet the textured sponge and use to blend edges. Rinse sponges.
4. Paint upper areas of the water with the teal blue, adding white and blending the colors to create the surf.
5. Paint the base with the cobalt blue, adding teal and blending up toward the surf crest.
6. Apply white paint to textured sponge, blotting sponge on plate to remove excess paint. Gently apply to the edges of the surf just below the fins.
7. Apply a small amount black paint to the brush. Roll the brush tip to create a fine point to paint the dolphins eyes.
